

## FAS Extended Warranty Program Changes Effective January 1, 2013

- FAS will no longer offer commercial extended warranties, regardless of the equipment used.
- Parts Only coverage will no longer be an option.
- Accessories used in conjunction with, or to enhance the performance of the Equipment, or were not installed by the original manufacturer will not be eligible for coverage.
- Manual or digital thermostats must be listed on the registration form when purchasing an extended warranty to be covered.
- All equipment must be registered with the manufacturer within 90 days from the installation date to be eligible for coverage.
- Pre-authorization will continue to be required for all claims that exceed \$500, and for all claims involving a; compressor, condenser coil, or heat exchanger. Beginning January 1<sup>st</sup> FAS will also require all fan coil evaporator coil claims to be pre-authorized.
  - **We have found that in some cases it is more cost effective to replace the entire fan coil, rather than replacing the fan coil evaporator coil. In order to prevent any unnecessary evaporator coil replacement claims a pre-authorization will be required.**
- When eligible R410A refrigerant will be reimbursed at the dealer's cost not to exceed \$6.00 per pound; with the maximum amount on any claim being the manufacturer's recommended system charge with a lineset allowance of 25 feet.
- Proof of Purchase for replacement parts will be required on all parts claims to receive reimbursement for the parts and/or mark-up.
